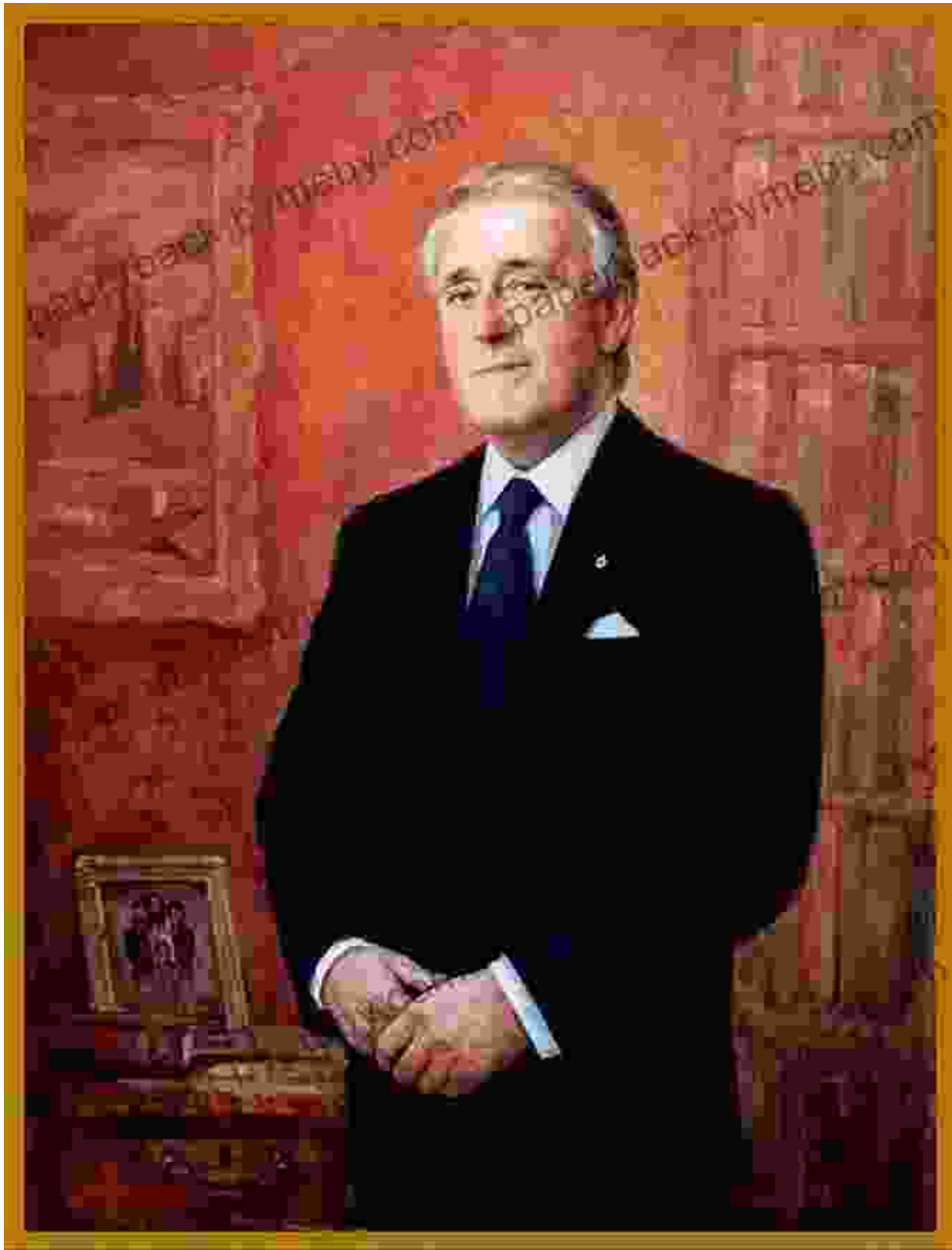


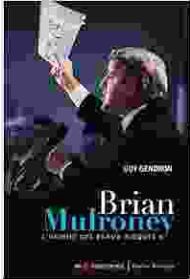
Brian Mulroney Homme Des Beaux Risques

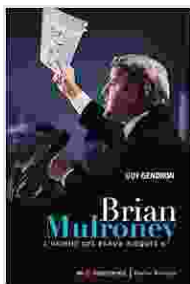
