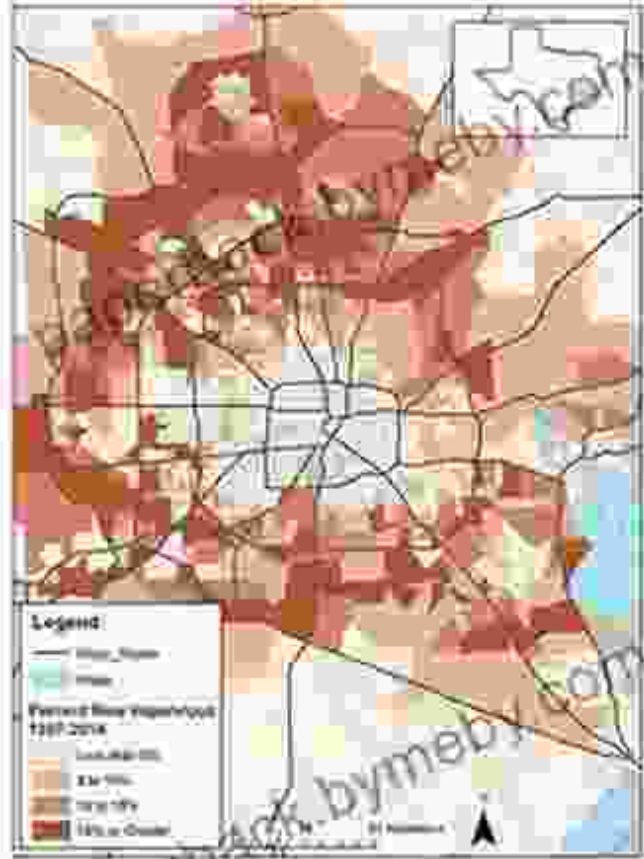

Percent impervious surfaces in 1997

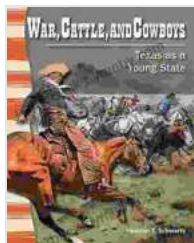


Percent new impervious surfaces, 1997 to 2016

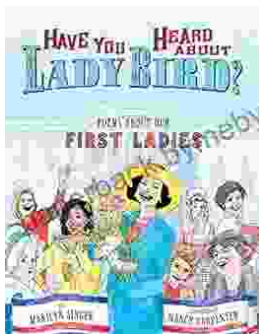
