

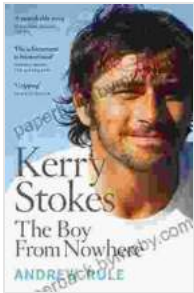
Kerry Stokes: The Boy from Nowhere

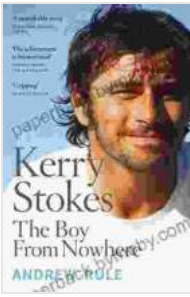

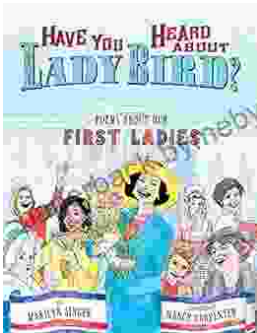

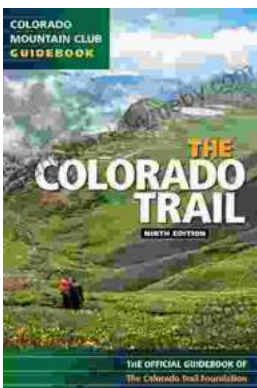
