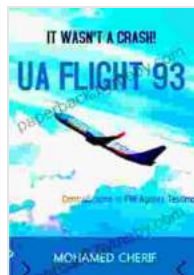


UA Flight 93: It Didn't Crash – The Untold Story of the 9/11 Heroes Who Fought Back

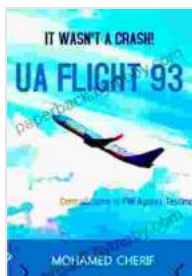
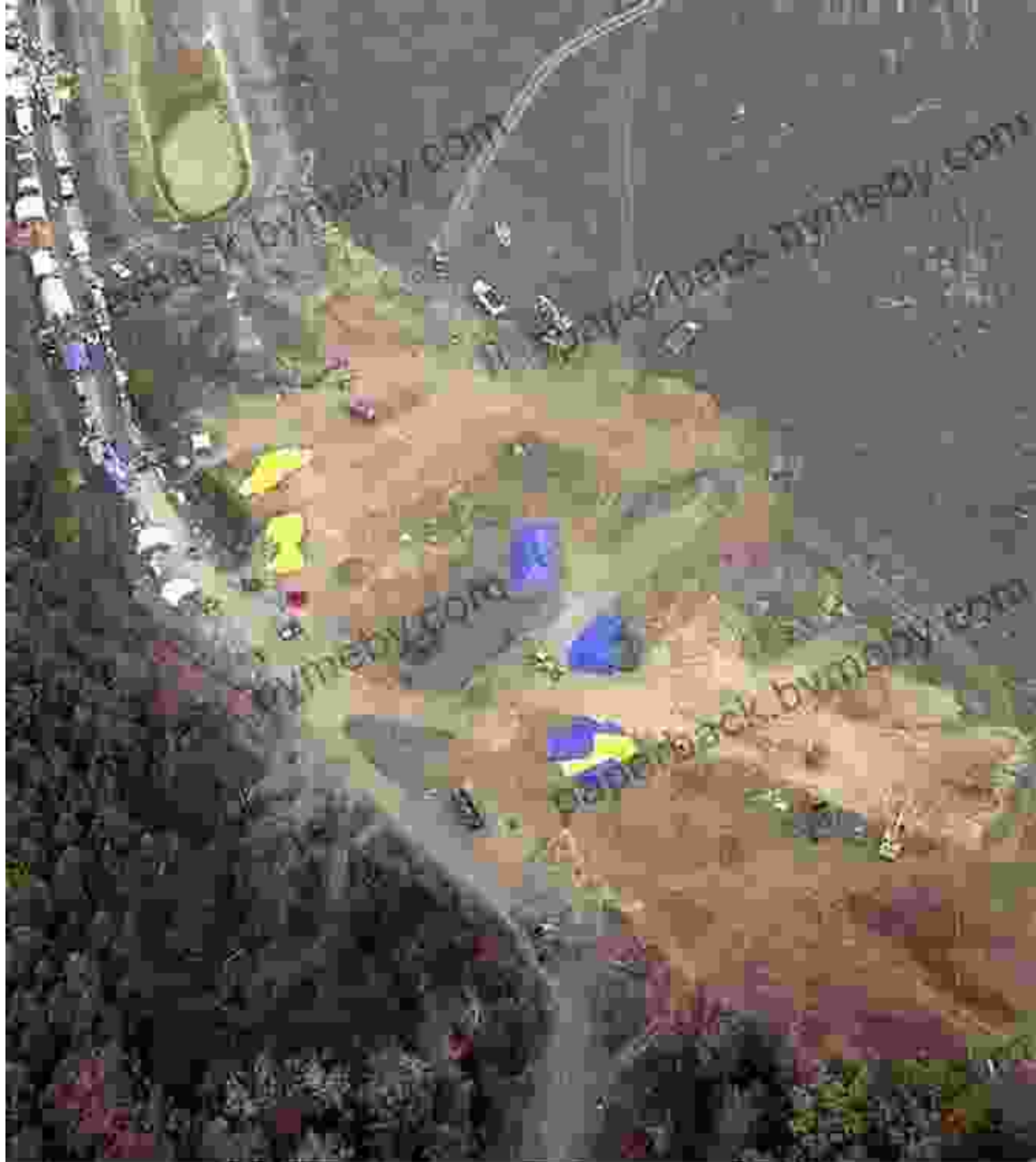
