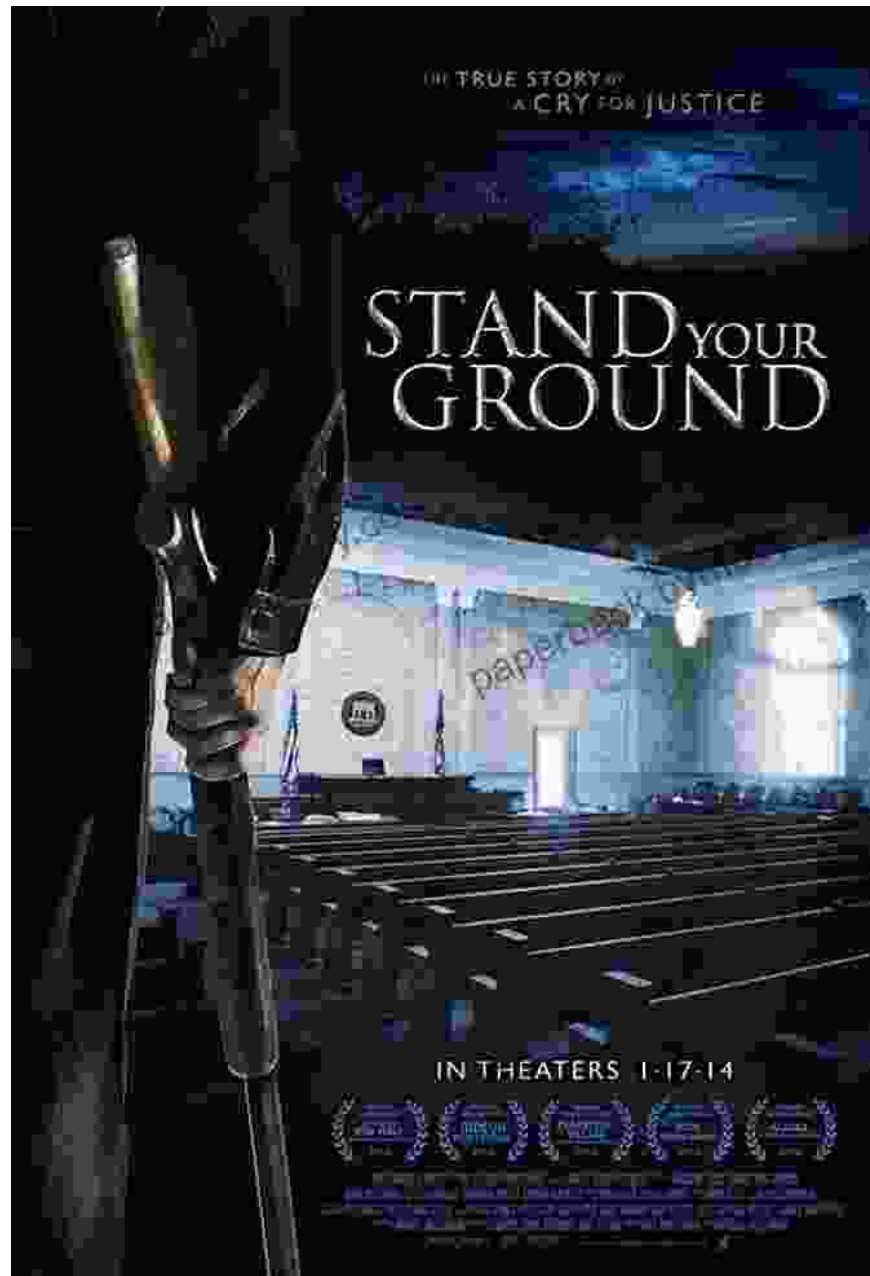
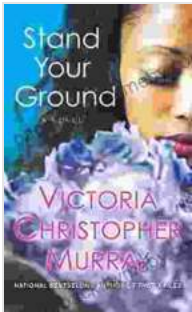

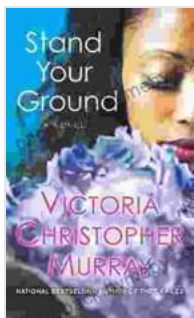
About the Author

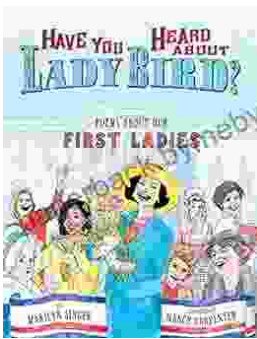

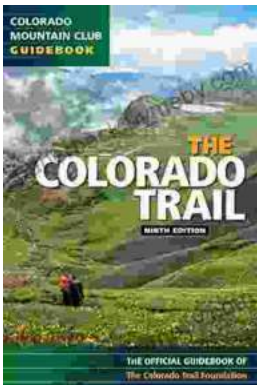
