



The Ocarina of Time: A Symphony of Time




The Ocarina of Time is a sacred musical instrument that allows its user to travel through time. It is said to have been created by the goddess Hylia



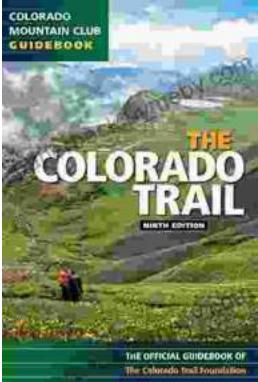
