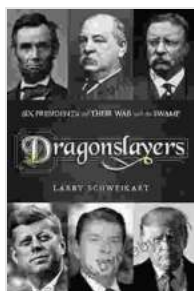

      - ▼ Money no longer would depend on gold supply

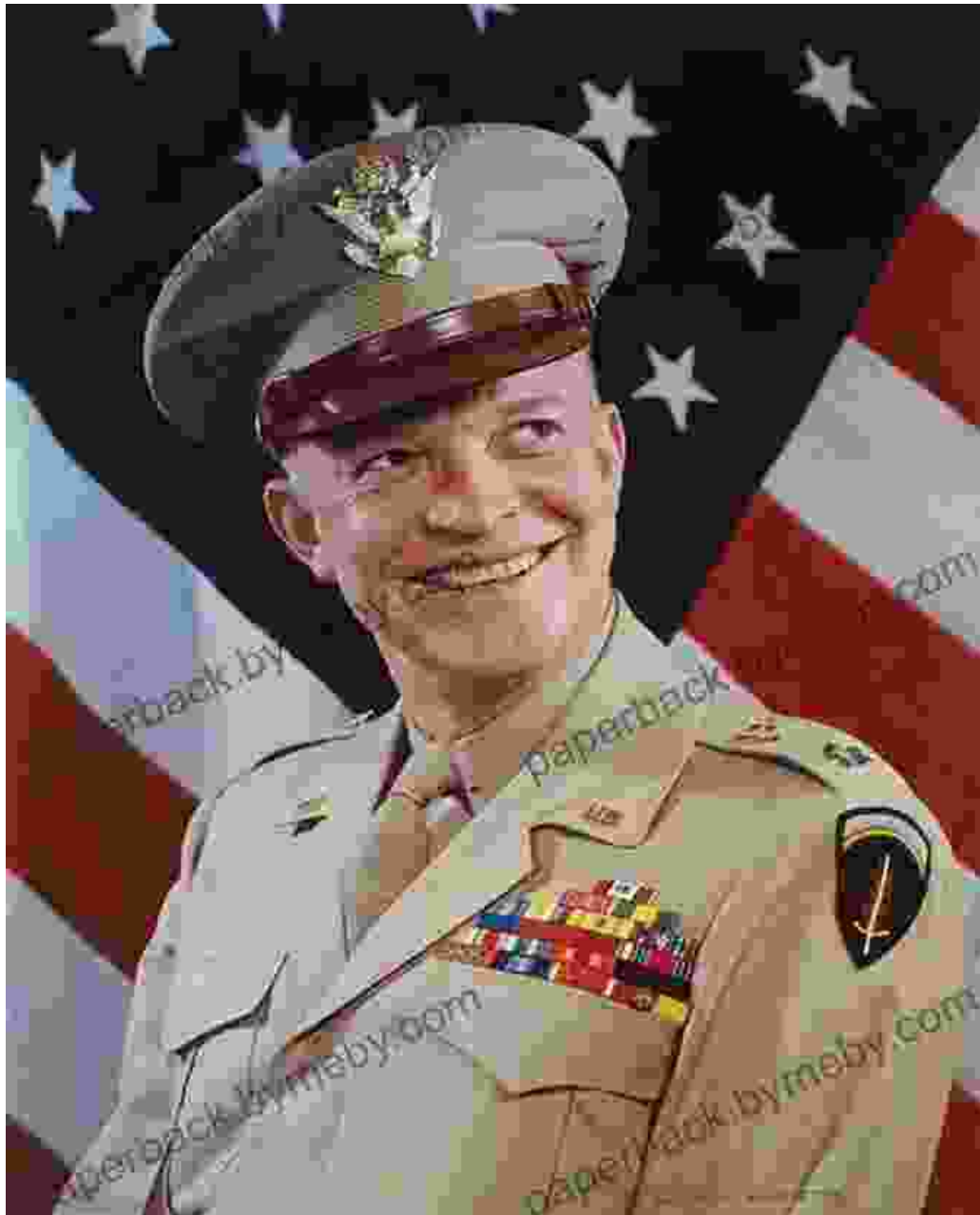

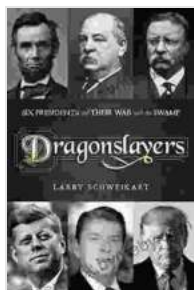
